

**IMPORTANT INFORMATION FOR MARINE USERS**

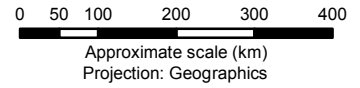
Commonwealth marine reserves are managed under transitional arrangements until management plans come into effect. Transitional arrangements involve **NO CHANGES ON THE WATER** for marine users. Note, there are no changes to management arrangements in the marine reserves that existed prior to the establishment of the new reserves, that is, the same restrictions on activities will continue to apply even where those reserves have been incorporated into new reserves.
